



**USA BASEBALL 16U WEST TEAM CHAMPIONSHIPS
PHOENIX, ARIZONA
JUNE 25, 2023 THROUGH June 30, 2023**



The USA Baseball 16U West Team Championships are an invite only tournament held in MLB Spring Training facilities in Glendale, Goodyear and Peoria, Arizona, hosted by USA Baseball. The tournament is the primary identification events for players to be considered for the USA Baseball's 17U National Team Development Programs. The best of the best in prep baseball come to Arizona each year for this tournament.

ELIGIBILITY

Players graduating in 2025 eligible to play, but only players born January 1, 2007, or later will be eligible to be selected by USA Baseball to the USA 16U National Team. At least six players on each team's roster be born in 2007.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

Players should plan to arrive anytime on June 23. Players should feel free to schedule departing flights in the late afternoon or evening of June 30, or anytime thereafter.

SCHEDULE AND GAME PLAY (Schedule may change this is just a sample)

There are no opening festival or team competitions for this tournament. The tournament is a 6-game guarantee with up to 9 games max. No testing anymore with USA Baseball. Three days of pool play will be followed by bracket play, including a consolation bracket (meaning a minimum of two bracket games).

TOURNAMENT COST

The total cost will be \$650 per player, payable to Donny Kadokawa via Check, Cash, Venmo Team Kado. A non-refundable deposit of \$350 is required to reserve your roster spot. The final payment will be due 30 days prior to the start of the event. The fee will include all games played. Please note we can't control the weather and if games get cancelled we are not responsible for giving families refund for airfare, Hotel etc. Please make sure you read this clearly.

Uniforms- Players need to purchase uniforms if needed 2 tops \$85 for the set. Hats will be \$25 per hat. Players must provide Navy belt, Navy socks and White Pants. 2 pants are recommended at the least.
